Guest Speaker

Greg Love introduced his friend Ric Maurovic who spoke on his art. He started his working life in his dream job of a livestock drover working in the sale yards at Gepps Cross. Injury led to his taking up painting and his first works depicted scenes of the cattle and sheep yards where he had worked.

He developed an interest in railway-centred art and this was amongst the first pieces of art that he ever sold. He realised that dedicated application to his art was the only way to success in his new career and this has stood him in good stead as his technique and reputation has grown and his works have become in considerable demand.

He expanded his subject matter and developed a particular interest in the built environment. Private art tuition opened up his mind to art history and theory and ideas of composition and colour and to the works of other artists. His work became more polished and less slavishly realistic and led naturally to the development of his own style.

He has held several solo exhibitions and was artist in residence for the Crafers freeway project and has been asked to create original works for the new airport complex.

He paints subject matter from all over the world but takes great pride in his paintings of Adelaide and South Australia.
