Rotary Information

In a new section of the meeting three Rotarians gave a brief overview of Rotary and what in means to them Bob Laws, Adrian Sobels and Sheila Evans gave a very informative session highlighting the positives that they have experienced through their membership in this organisation. Friendship, fellowship, confidence and new experiences were the common theme.

Sergeant's Session

The Sergeant was Michael Tait who needs to be congratulated on a job well done on his first attempt. Geoff Howland won the Lucky Squares and Norm Wallace won the wine.

Guest Speaker

Adam Heaton was introduced by the Chairperson of the night Chandra Sluggett.

Adam gave us a very passionate overview of the dilemma that affects the children in Zimbabwe who have been orphaned by AIDS and who may also have the HIV virus and will eventually develop AIDS. Adam is involved in developing a centre "resort" for these children to be cared for during their short life span or until survivors are old enough and able to fend for themselves.

Currently accommodation is being built in a unit style facility with carers available to administer simple first aid and simple medication to them. Medication that is given for the disease process is administered by a clinic outside of this "resort" facility. Transport is required for this process to occur.

Adam is seeking assistance of any kind from money to tools or medical supplies to bedding that can be used by the occupants. He concluded his talk with a very emmotive video of the community members in the local environment.

Chandra thanked Adam for his presentation and President Ron presented Adam with a Rotary wineglass.
