They have actually won an award from Rotary for this program Children in the program must be referred with a medical certificate certify that the child does have malnourishment as a health problem. They are thrilled that our club is trying to help 300+ children with this program.

Guest Speaker

Chairperson Sheila Evans introduced our Guest Speaker this evening. Jim Donaghy was introduced to the club the development manager at Centacare and has been there since 2000 He previously worked overseas in Nepal and Northern Ireland as a volunteer. He has also had 10 years as Director of Development at Black Friars College and Rostrevor College. Jim talked about the role of Centacare, which is the Catholic Family Services. From the brochure the Mission Statement reads: "Centacare aims to provide clients with human services that will enhance their quality of life and positive participation within the community. "

Jim gave an overview of the services that are provided and these include Community Services, which include Housing Programs and Intervention Programs. Support for the intellectually disabled and their families Family and Relationship Services Access which aims to give support to organisations and their families and also support programs for pregnant and parenting young mothers.

Jim went on to highlight the latest project that he is involved with and so the title "Respite a true gift of Time" This project is aimed at giving families respite time from caring for a child between the ages of 13 and 30 in the form of a home environment for a few days where care can be provided 24hours to enable the rest of the family to do activities that we may take for granted eg. going to the movies, out to dinner etc. They will also be able to arrange outings for their client group in this home care environment, which will also help to enhance the client's lifestyle.
