The Sergeant was David Middleton. Mavis Martin won the Lucky Squares and Alex Johnson won the wine.

Guest Speaker

Chairperson Sheila Evans introduced our Guest Speaker this evening, John Harley from the Office of the Public Advocate. The office was created in 1993. John took on the potion in 1998. The office is an independent office the same as the way as the Auditor General and Solicitor General. He is not subject to any ministerial direction and he can be only removed by a resolution of parliament. A report is written each year and presented in parliament.

He has direct access to his minister and those are attorney general the Minister for Health and the Minister for Family and communities. This communication avenue is important so that any concerns regarding the services that are provided to any people with a mental incapacity. People with a mental incapacity are those with intellectually disabilities, mental disabilities, brain damage, and neurological disorders, in this group are those people who suffer from Alzheimer's disease.

John's role is to protect their rights and interests by being an Advocate in the terms of systemic advocacy to look at service both in the public and private areas, the role of Investigator at the direction of the guardianship board. He is also an educator it is to endeavour to educate the public regarding the 3 acts that he is involved with. The Mental Health Act, The Guardianship and

Administration Act and the Consent To Treatment And Palliative Care Act. This education involves many nursing homes and hospitals and as a result of this John sits on 4 or 5 ethic committees. John highlighted that with Ethics there is never a right answer. His last function is Guardian of last resort.
