Information on OSSA

John Russell gave a presentation on what **OSSAA** (Overseas Surgical and Specialists Association of Australia) is. John spoke about a program in Soe in East Timor where members of our club were involved in a Clean Water Supply Project that enable the hospital to have a dedicated water supply which is imperative for successful theatre procedures.

Surgeons from Adelaide under the leadership of Dr Mark Moore and Dr Peter Riddell go to East Timor on Team visits to conduct surgery. The doctors that visit the area provide surgical and reconstructive rehabilitation services and also training in the delivery of these services, to disadvantaged people particularly in East Timor. Over the last financial year six team visits have taken place.

Fundraising is very important to make this project work and during the past year there has been a very successful Film Evening and we have heard about the forthcoming fashion parade. Our Rotary Club has three members on the OSSAA Management Committee: John Russell, Alex Jonson and Bob Laws.
