The Sergeant for the night was Bob Laws. No-one won the Lucky Square, as it was unsold; therefore the Club was the winner. John Peacham won the wine.

Our Guest Speaker

Dr Andrew Thornton spoke on the subject of Sleep Disorders. Andrew works in the Department of Thoracic Medicine at the Royal Adelaide hospital and has done so for quite a few years. He is a Senior Hospital Scientist and also the Manager of the Sleep Disorders Unit and the Lung Function Laboratory. His other hat is the Administration manager of the Chest Clinic.

Andrew developed an interest in Sleep Disorders back in the very early 80's and was there in its infancy before it became a well-published medical condition. Andrew was instrumental in setting up the very first Sleep Laboratory in Adelaide at the Royal Adelaide Hospital and in fact was one of the original makers of the 1st CPAP masks, which was made using Dental impression material, and syringes. Also Andrew has been very much a part of the IT area within this Department bringing the Thoracic Medicine Department on line in 1982 before the time of a lot of other areas. On a personal note it has been stated by one of his colleagues, and it is not Joan Reed, that being a boy from Elizabeth he does barrack for Central Districts.

Andrew gave a very detailed talk on Sleep Apnoea, which was very well received by the audience, especially his little touch of multiculturalism. Sleep Apnoea is a condition that mostly affects males and can cause quite a few problems with normal everyday functioning due to lower oxygen levels in the blood due to a person having periods during their sleep when they stop breathing. Joan has some pamphlets for those who may be interested in finding out more.
