Guest Speakers

Chairman was Darryl Foote who introduced guest speaker Patrick McBride of Bartercard:

Patrick started of by saying that he was a former Rotarian at Whyalla-Norrie in the old district 250, which is now 9500.

He was also on the district Rotaract committee in Pt Lincoln. As a 22 year old he had the privilege of being a guest speaker at the Chicago Rotary Club where he spoke to 1,000 male members (no woman members at that stage in Rotary) and also visited the New York Club where he rubbed shoulders with Norman Vincent Peel and large shipping magnates.

Patrick was involved with the setting up of Price Attack Stores in Adelaide before he established Bartercard in SA in 1992.

Bartercard was first established in Qld in 1991. Bartercard is a trading exchange of goods and services used mainly for small to medium businesses, and is the largest known trading exchange system in the world. It won an award in 2002 as Australias top franchise business.

Bartercard also sponsors a lot of sporting events and sporting bodies, e.g. AFL clubs etc.

Bartercard in a nutshell is a business network that can introduce you to thousands of new customers eager to buy your product or service. It provides increased sales and profits and guarantees you new referrals.

RYLA Report to the Board Rotary Club of Unley.

Summary of report presented to the Board by Joan Reed, New Generations Chairperson.

In the year 2003 -2004 the rotary club of Unley undertook to host the RYLA seminar in 2005 -2006. This project also encompassed the sponsoring of 6 students to participate in the seminar. 3 of these students were to come from disadvantaged backgrounds. The information to the club was brief in that the actual costs that the club would incur were not confirmed in writing.

In 2004 Joan was approached by Bernie Boxer, the current chairperson of the district committee to undertake the role of Administrator of the seminar. Joan appointed 2 hosts in Jill Reynolds and Martin Cooper to also attend the RYLA seminar. It was also an expectation of Joan, Jill & Martin to live on site during the seminar. Greg Love and Ron Schubert were also appointed as stand-ins should one of us be unable to attend the seminar.

In the months approaching the seminar it became clear through attendances at District Committee meetings that the host club of the RYLA seminar be responsible for the following activities:

- ?? Photocopier for the printing of the bulletin, and the consumables for this process to occur
- ?? The graduation dinner for the awardees, directors, hosts and administrator
- ?? Transport to & from the seminar for the awardees dinner
- ?? A BBQ with drinks is also to be provided for the participants following an orienteering event
- ?? Preparing and printing of the program

Final numbers for the seminar were not available until one week prior and this made things very difficult with advertising the Graduation Dinner and with the costing of the event.

Overall, predicted costs totalled \$5,005, which included cost of dinner, photocopier, bus, folders and programs, BBQ & drinks and incidentals.

The eventual cost of the seminar was much less at \$2,800.50 thanks to Joan Reed who donated paper for bulletin and printing of programs. The bus did not turn up for the dinner so that saved \$295 plus some of the said costs were under proposed budget.

All in all it was a successful seminar with positive feedback from the awardees and directors. Joan Reed is now a committee member for the RYLA-RYPEN District Committee.

Joan would like to thank Martin Cooper for organising a successful graduation dinner at Ayers House, all volunteers who helped with the BBQ, especially Ron Schubert who collected the Hyde Park trailer and to Jerry Casburn for donating hats and pens for the awardees.
