Ron Schubert advised that subscriptions are now due and if everyone could please pay promptly.

Sheila Evans spoke on the Mental Health Forum to be held at the Unley Civic Centre on 11/10/05. The forum is in partnership with Hyde Park Club and The Unley Council. The forum will make us aware that 1 in 5 people are affected by mental health and it is an ever-growing concern in our community. The forum is also open to the public, so if you have friends or family that would like to attend please bring them on the night. Dinner will be at Mama Carmela's at 6.00pm at members' cost. The forum will then commence at 7.00pm at Unley Civic Centre. Sheila has asked that members help with supper on the night.

Sergeants Session

Jerry Casburn was the sergeant for the evening. Jerry came up with some new ideas for fines. The way he is going we won't have to pay member subscriptions any more as he makes up for it at meetings. Kevin Rogers won the wine and the lucky square went to Chandra Sluggett.

Club Assembly

No guest speaker tonight as Club Assembly was held. Chairpersons from each committee presented their reports.

Community: No report presented due to Laurie Madigan being with family for the birth of his 3rd child. Report to be presented on 18/10/05.

International: This committee is to have a more hands on approach by sending club members to the various countries, plus set up an international network. One of the main areas that require assistance is in Africa to provide children with shoes and clothing. Unley Club was also toasted at a recent meeting of a Philippines Rotary Club for our support.

Club Service: No report submitted due to Greg Love being in Korea. Report to be presented on 18/10/05.

Membership: Membership drive was classed as a success. 2,000 flyers distributed with 32 people interested. Of the 2 meetings held in September 13 visitors attended. The main aim of the drive was to obtain 8 to 10 new members. It was also discussed that if any member were absent for two meetings without apology they would receive a phone call from the Membership Committee asking for a reason for their absence.

New Generations: This committee amalgamated with vocational this year. Only 1 formal meeting has been held in August 2005 thus far to discuss National Youth Science Seminar. Police Officer of the year award was established in 1978. This award was well advertised by way of A4 posters sent to clubs in the district along with A3 posters sent to all police stations in the state. Emails to country radio stations and papers were also submitted and there was great support by the country folk. A budget of \$2,400 was

allocated for posters and advertising. Award nominees were presented in Rundle Mall on the 2nd Tuesday of May with the annual award dinner being held on 16/5/05 at the Unley Club. Vocational will again concentrate on assisting unemployed people in the community.

Treasurer's Report: Presented by Alex Johnson. A copy can be obtained from Alex.

Thrift Shop: Takings are down on previous year by around \$300pw. Costs are up due to higher rental in new premises. Shop extensions are also to be planned to move the back wall to provide more space. As Jo Blowes is still away it is imperative that 4 members are allocated for each Saturday roster. The biggest problem at the moment with the Thrift Shop is the weekday roster with volunteers ageing and unable to attend. It is also getting to the stage where the shop is closing early some days. The committee is currently looking at Volunteers Association assistance at a fee of \$80 pa. A concern is also the screening process of volunteers but many members advised that the association has a very thorough screening process in place. The association needs to be advised of exactly what type of people the club requires. Geoff Hill is also to re-visit the Unley Council volunteers to see if they can assist.

Open Forum: Only topic that was brought up was that dinners being held each month outside of the club be on a less frequent basis due to the costs.

Peter Ochota, Assistant DG, spoke briefly to inform new members and visitors about Rotary International. Peter also advised that his role is to assist and not dictate to the 57 clubs in district 9520. A letter and invitation will also be received shortly relating to ROMAC, which will be held next year on the River Torrens, and asked that all clubs in the district get involved.
