Guest Speaker

Bob Laws: Chair

Nick Xenophon: MLA in South Australia

Nick Xenophon was born in Adelaide, South Australia in 1959. He studied law at the University of Adelaide and graduated in 1981.

He was admitted to the Bar of the Supreme Court of South Australia in 1982.

Since January 1984 he has been the principal of his own law firm, Xenophon & Co., which is a four practitioner legal practice dealing exclusively in personal injury claims. From 1994 to March 1997 he was President of the South Australian branch of the Australian Plaintiff Lawyers? Association, an organisation dedicated to protecting the rights of injured victims of accidents and professional negligence.

In July 1994, following legislative changes passed by South Australian Parliament, slot machines were introduced into South Australian hotels, bars and clubs. At his practice and in the community Nick began to see the social devastation caused by slot machines.

He formed a community association, called the "No Pokies Campaign", in March 1997 and stood on a "No Pokies" ticket for the Legislative Council of South Australia. He was elected following the state election of 11 October 1997, being the first independent candidate elected to the Legislative Council in its 140 year history. He has been elected to serve the State of South Australia until the year 2006.

Nick Xenophon is the son of a Greek mother, from the town of Corinth, and a Cypriot father, from the village of Poliptipos.

Nick's address was thought provoking and at time very sad and other times, very funny.
