Rotary Club of Unley in Action

We have had 2 club assemblies, and our AGM, 2 restaurant nights with our partners, conducted a Mental health forum in partnership with Hyde Park, held an Information Evening for potential new members, have inducted 5 new members and had a visit from our mother club Adelaide.

We have had social evenings, around a Quails and Polenta theme, attended the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra's Symphony in the Serengeti at Monarto Zoo. Others are planned including a Masquerade Ball. Our Christmas function was a reverse Santa held at the Unley Citizens Centre and catered locally, with gifts for male teenagers distributed through the Migrant Resource Centre. We had breakfast with Eastwood and Hyde Park to celebrate the advent of Christmas.

Unley has provided shelter boxes to replace the ones sent to the relief for Pakistan people affected by the earthquake. We were instrumental through one of our members in setting up the EDS volunteer day. We have held, in partnership with the Unley Council, Carols in the Rotunda for the community. We have again supported OSSAA with a \$5000 donation and RYWELL with \$2000. We have supported a literacy programme in the Philippines with the provision of computers through DIK and we have supplied modems to assist underprivileged indigenous youth. Our community service continues to support local projects. We have graduated our indigenous medical student who is now working as a fully qualified, registered doctor at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital. Our annual Police Officer of the Year award, in partnership with the SA Police will be presented at a dinner on May 16.

Our Thrift shop operates on Unley Road and is manned by volunteers and Rotary members. All goods are gratefully received. All donations of volunteer hours are also gratefully received.

Other fund raising has included wine sales, the usual Christmas cakes, puddings and cards. We assisted Broken Hill with the Indian bag sales. Recently we have received Tax deductible gift status.

All in all Unley is a great club!
