Guest Speaker

Richard Maurovic was born in Salisbury, South Australia in 1963. A former stockman and drover, he has since represented Australia, at an elite level, in wheelchair fencing and wheelchair rugby (Murder Ball). Ric has now been painting for 15 years.

Ric has had a number of previous contacts with the Club. He spoke to us in March 2004 and we purchased a painting from him that now hangs in the Unley Civic Centre. Ric and his wife Pat were our introduction to the Veneto Club and their Quail nights.

Apart from the odd still life, Richard paints locations such as airports, highways, shipping ports and freight terminals that are common in an urban and industrial society.

Ric detailed to the Club his process of art creation using photos and drawing followed by transferring his visions onto canvas over pencilled grids. He believes in a "clean desk" policy and puts all he work and materials away at the end of each work day. He sees himself as a man with a 9 to 5 job and that is to create art and to sell that art. He doesn't work by "brilliant flashes" or midnight sessions.

Ric said "Architectural details, industrial design and colourful road signs are placed within the composition to provide an interruption and impact statement or to complement the subject matter so that the viewer is able to see what the artist is seeing. To visit different cities and capture subject matter with fresh eyes gives the locals an opportunity to see their own environs with a totally new focus."

Brightly coloured road signs are an important source of subject material in Richard's work, influenced by Edward Hopper, Jeffrey Smart and the Precisionists.

Club members enjoyed the Maurovics' beautiful converted corner shop home and Ric's and others' art displayed there. The night was well catered by Steven Finos from the Deli next to the Thrift Shop; all in all a very enjoyable night.
