Guest Speakers: Dr Karli Hayward & Natalie Moore

Chandra Sluggett introduced our now graduated Indigenous Medical Scholarship Student, Dr Karli Hayward, is now working at the QEH, and our new Indigenous Medical Scholarship Student, Natalie Moore, is doing Paramedical Studies at Flinders University.

Dr Hayward told us that she left school at year 11 and was pregnant at that time. She now has four children. She completed a Foundation Course for Indigenous Students at Adelaide Uni and went on into a six-year medical course at QEH. When she started her and other indigenous students were told to "leave their culture at the door!" Karli thought that was very hard and she and others lobbied for change in that regards. Her current plans are to do one year's GP training and then to get out so to work with her people in the field.

Natalie Moore's father's people come from Derby, three hours from Broome. She has always lived in Adelaide and detailed to us her love and involvement in sport. She finished Year 12 last year and is now enrolled in a three-year Bachelor of Health Science and Paramedical course at Flinders Uni. During Year 12 she was a National Science Student and attended the Youth Parliament in Canberra.

Currently she is studying Critical Thinking and Interpersonal Skills which she believes is greatly assiting her in all aspects of her life.

Natalie is funded, as was Karli, by Rotary and the SA Health Department.

Both Karli and Natalie sincerely thanked the club and look forward to visiting again. After questions and positive comments from the floor, President Kaylene presented Karli with red roses.
