#### **Guest Speakers**

Our Chairman for the night, Bob Mills, introduced Mark Haynes, Director of Haysman Financial Services and Chairman of the "Chad Hancock Cancer Foundation" accompanying Mark was Morgan Atkinson who is a qualified sports scientist and a past sufferer of cancer. Mark became involved with the foundation following the death of Chad, his son's best friend.

Mark started by highlighting the gaps in our support for young adults suffering from cancer. Good mechanisms exist for supporting children and youths under 18 but there the major support programmes cease to help. Additionally, during the period of illness and prior to his death there was very little information made available to Chad to allow him to understand what was happening. The aim of the Chad Hancock Foundation is to assist young adults who have been diagnosed and continue to suffer from cancer. Funds raised provide assistance to the development and funding of programmes and resources to make it easier for young adults to receive help and access information throughout their journey. Mark introduced Morgan who in the final stages of year 11 at High School and in the midst of a promising sports career was diagnosed with acute leukaemia. Morgan spoke of the shock and the implications which included a high probability of his inability to have children. Treatments including chemotherapy went on for two and a half years and the cancer went into remission, only to return three years later. Morgan went through further treatment including bone marrow transplant from his sister who was a compatible donor, fortunately the cancer is again in remission. Treatment affected all aspects of life from education to sport.

The bottom line message from our speakers was a great need for better support, rehabilitation programmes to deal with the problems arising from the cancer and its treatment, as well as support for parents and families.
