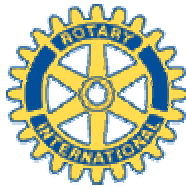

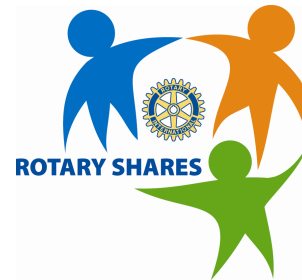

1. We have received an invitation for interested members and their spouses to attend the RAWCS Annual Presentation Dinner. (Rotary Australia World Community Service). The dinner will be at the West Adelaide Function Centre on Friday 24th August. The cost of the two-course meal is \$26 per head and you buy your own drinks. Any members interested in attending should see me and I will provide them with the details.
2. This year the District 9520 Conference has been bought forward to October 12th to 14th at Westminster School. There will be no accommodation required and there is a pricing structure that allows you to attend the conference and not the dinner on Saturday Night if you prefer. The cost of the dinner is \$70 per head and the cost of the conference component is \$110 for early registration prior to 30th July. The programme looks interesting and I suggest that those interested in attending come along armed with our chequebooks or credit cards to the next meeting.
3. Committee meetings are due to be held this week and I call on committees to prepare their plans for the year and also a budget. The budgets will need to be finalised at the meetings next month for approval by the Board at the August Meeting.

Our Guest Speaker – Adrian Edgar

Bob Mullins introduced our guest speaker. Adrian Edgar is the General Manager of the Kooyonga Golf Club. He has had 20 years experience in banking and finance. His last 10 years have been in the Golfing world, 5 years at Glenelg, 3 years at Indooroopilly and the last 2½ years at the Kooyonga Golf Club. He has been married to Leila for 35 years (she sold his golf clubs before they married without him knowing) and has three adult children. He enjoys watching golf. Adrian spoke about the requirements to set up and run the Jacob's Creek open. This tournament attracted 106 players both Nationally and Internationally, with 68 from Australia. It was broadcast all over the world with 45 million viewers in the US, 30 Million in Europe, Asia, and New Zealand and an increase in 22% in the ratings in Australia. The event attracts 300 volunteers and takes months of preparation with getting the course ready. This year's event was very successful with a profit of about \$50,000.

It was surprising to hear that golf has noticed a decline in memberships but Adrian has put that down to lifestyle choices in that people like to have a variety of courses to play at. About 5% of people over 50 play golf.
