Our Guest Speaker: Michael on Genomics Plants.

Chairperson President David introduced Michael who is an engineer at the Waite Institute Genomics Plant centre.

This department employs 120 scientists and has 36 PHD students and is the leader in its field. They have a high school program that involves more than 4,000 students involved in campus activities. Funding for the projects and research is through Government funding and through farmers funding. They have just been refunded for another 5 years. Michael took us for a tour through the laboratories.

The ACPFG is working to improve the resistance of wheat and barley to hostile environmental conditions, using functional genomics technologies. Scientists at the ACPFG are focusing on stresses that impact agriculture in Australia, including drought, salinity, high or low temperatures and mineral deficiencies or toxicities.
