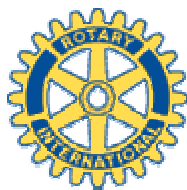

Sergeants Session

The sergeant's session was conducted swiftly by Greg McLeod; the lucky square was won by Bob Mills.

Guest Speaker: Margie Maloney - "An update on our Special Project: OSSAA"

Our guest speaker this evening was introduced by Bob Laws. Margie is a South Australian, born and bred. She was trained at the Royal Adelaide Hospital, plus she undertook an Operating Room course in the UK. She works in the plastic surgery unit of the Royal Adelaide where she was recruited to volunteer for OSSAA by Dr Mark Moore. Since then she has undertaken 12 trips for OSSAA to eastern Indonesia and East Timor. In addition, she has volunteered for an additional 9 trips for other humanitarian organisations to Pakistan and Aceh.

Margie spoke of her trips overseas to East and West Timor and also to Flores where she has undertaken her work with OS. It is through her work with Dr Mark Moore that she has been involved in this project. Through out her talk we saw slides of some of the clients she has been involved with and it was very evident how passionate Margie is with her work. The trips are for a week at a time and the days start at 8am and usually do not finish until 8pm. The conditions are very basic with one Doctor travelling with his own toilet seat (you had to be there). Margie finds this work very rewarding and also challenging but finds the experience of changing peoples lives very humbling. We can only say a big thank you.
