

#### Inter Club Meeting



In addition to fellowship, the meeting program included talks by two Prospect Rotarians on the DREAMIN foundation and Project Vietnam (see below).

# Guest Speakers

Prospect Rotarian Dr Suren Krishnan gave a presentation on the DREAMIN Foundation – a Club Project in conjunction with the Royal Adelaide Hospital Cranio

Facial and Ear Nose & Throat Units. The Foundation was established in memory of Past Rotarian Dean Richards. Suren is a respected International Volunteer in the areas of Ear Nose and Throat issues.



The Foundation works in conjunction with ROMAC and OSSAA. It is also involved with AusAid funded projects, with much of that work being undertaken in the Pacific Islands.

Financial support comes from many Rotary Clubs and corporations and medical practitioners.

Rotarian Arch Boonen gave a presentation on Project Vietnam.

The Project is supported by the DREAMIN Foundation and was established as result of a visit to Vietnam by Rotarian Denise Palmer where she became aware of the children suffering genetic disabilities as a result of the Vietnam War.

Denise in conjunction with Suren and other Adelaide volunteers are presently developing Intervention and Training programmes for Paediatricians and Physiotherapists within the Hue Medical College. Members of the Rotary Club of Prospect went with Denise to Vietnam to determine the extent and need of paediatric physiotherapy services and the equipment and training that would be necessary to address a largely neglected problem within the community. The Club has embraced the project wholeheartedly and would welcome direct input from the Unley Club.
