Rotarians Against Malaria



The Program was initiated in the Solomon Islands in about 2001. At that time there were 700 proven cases of malaria/1000 people/year.

In 2012 the figure has reduced to less than 44 cases/1000. In one province, malaria is close to being eradicated. This ensures that the infant mortality is significantly reduced. Also the adults are healthier and able to participate.
