Welcome to this month's District Governor's Newsletter. **March is Rotary's special month to reflect on Literacy** which is one of the six main Areas of Focus of Rotary's Service that has been identified in helping people not only in developing countries but also at home. Without the ability to read and understand what is written young children and adults will be left behind. The failure to comprehend will mean that many will not be able to take medicine, or understand where or when they could seek help and support.

Many activities occurred during February including the pre-release film entitled **"The Most Exotic Marigold Hotel"** being shown to raise funds for the Rotary Foundation. Perhaps the timing was not the most favourable for our District as only 87 attended from our district in the Piccadilly Theatre although there were over 400 from both Districts. On the other hand clubs in Broken Hill had 104 attend the pre-release making a successful fundraising event for The Foundation. Well done to the Broken Hill clubs and also those who supported the film release in Adelaide.

Club members should also be encouraged to identify young people from members of their family, friends, work colleagues etc.

### **REACH OUT TO ROTARY ALUMNI IN YOUR COMMUNITY**

### **Three ways clubs can turn New Generations participants into the next generation of Rotarians.**

What would our clubs look like if we invited every former Rotaractor, Rotary Foundation Ambassadorial Scholar, and Rotary Youth Exchange student to join Rotary?

Hundreds of talented, dedicated, and energetic young men and women participate in these Rotary programs annually. Yet, less than **3 percent** of program alumni are Rotary members.

"We recognized them as exceptional young people — even spent time and money to educate and send them to other countries as Rotary ambassadors. Aren't these the very people we want as Rotarians?" asks Rotary coordinator Judi Beard-Strubing.

### **Consider these approaches to recruiting alumni:**

**1. Reconnect.** "Constant networking and reconnecting" are key to recruiting alumni, says Peter Kyle, a former Ambassadorial Scholar. Kyle, who chairs the Rotary Foundation Alumni Advisory Committee, organized a monthly happy hour to reach out to alumni living in the Washington, D.C., area.

One-third of the attendees are Rotary program alumni, and the hope is that this eventually will become a new club.

**2. Network.** "Rotary calls it vocational service and fellowship. We call it networking," says Daniel Sturgeon, a former Rotary Peace Fellow and a member of the Rotary E-Club of Southwest, USA. "And it's very important to (alumni)." Sturgeon's club is taking the concept one step further by creating a network of peace experts. The club's goal is to recruit 50 peace fellows over the next three years, whom clubs and districts can tap for advice and help on their service projects.

**3. Make Rotary relevant.** Sturgeon concedes that the hardest part of selling Rotary to a busy young professional is that it is asking for yet another commitment. But the opportunity for community involvement is a big draw. "Alumni want their commitment to make a difference," he says. And Kyle suggests making sure that your club's meeting topics are relevant to alumni careers and interests.

### Matching Grants:

The closing date for Matching Grants this year is 31 March. It appears the District will have a considerable District Designated Grant sum unallocated this year unless there are some late applications from clubs. For every \$ a club puts into a Matching Grant project, the Foundation matches it with \$3.50. ### Funding partners:



The Global Financial Crisis has left its mark on health and medical research funding agencies around the world. Local disasters such as recent droughts, cyclones, floods and bushfires also have an effect.

However, thanks to the dedication of a number of Rotary Clubs and Districts around the country, Australian Rotary Health is pleased to announce that its Funding Partner program continues to grow from strength to strength, despite its supporters many competing priorities.

Researching topics as diverse as epilepsy, cancer, motor neuron disease and depression, these scholars are providing vital new insights into a number of health and medical fields important to Rotarians. Now in its tenth year, Australian Rotary Health's Funding Partner PhD program provides a tax-free stipend of \$29,000 a year to a researcher who is conducting a study into a particular area of health. The field of choice is determined by the Rotary Club who sponsors the research project, allowing Rotarians even more influence over how their donation is spent.

## POLIO ERADICATION UPDATE



### "Rotary's Challenge reaches US\$200 million"

Rotary International has succeeded in meeting the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation's US\$200 million match in funding for polio eradication,

raising more than \$202.6 million as of 17 January.

"We'll celebrate this milestone, but it doesn't mean that we'll stop raising money or spreading the word about polio eradication," Rotary Foundation Trustee John F. Germ told Rotary leaders at the International Assembly in San Diego, California, USA. **"We can't stop until our entire world is certified as polio-free".**
