

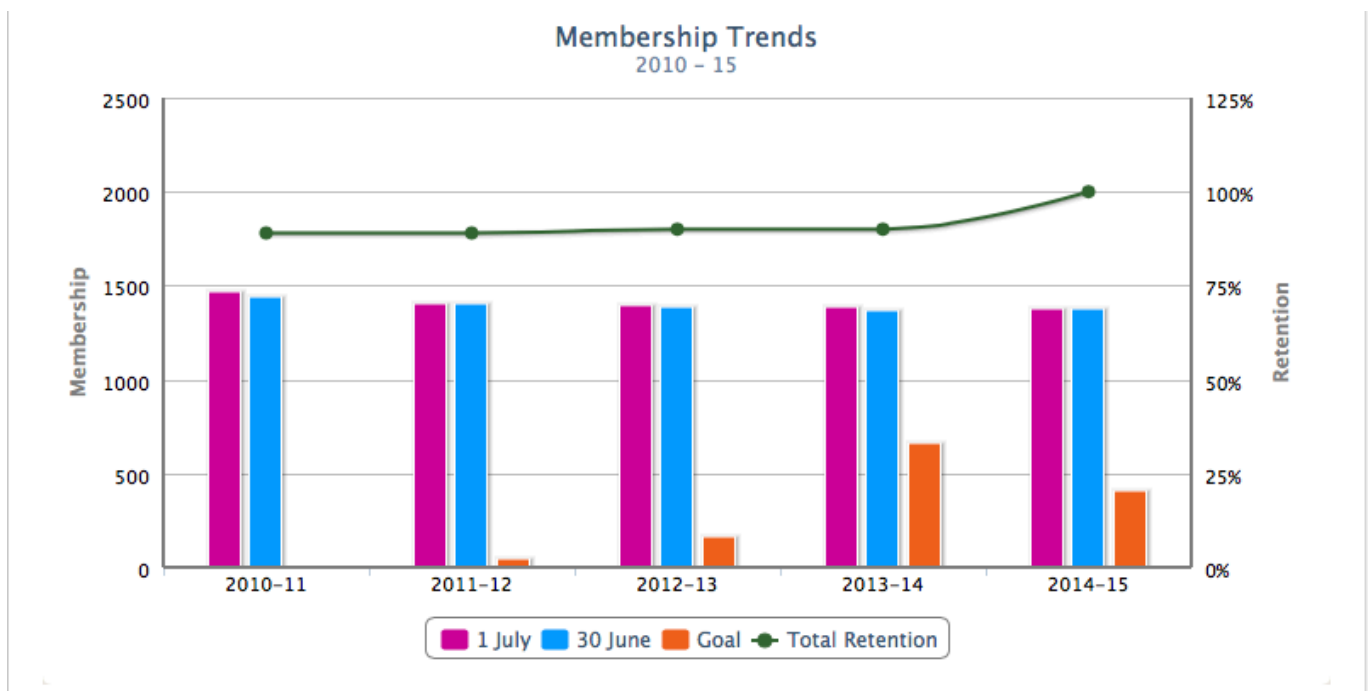

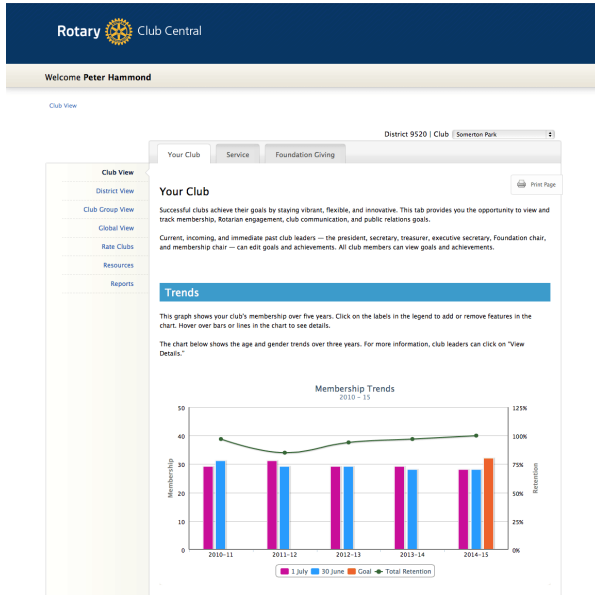

Your Rotary Club trends and goals for Membership, Service and The Rotary Foundation can be seen on the Rotary International website in Rotary Club Central.

Membership goals can be viewed under the **Your Club** tab; Service goals can be viewed under the **Service** tab and Foundation goals can be viewed under the **Foundation Giving** tab.

Current, incoming and immediate past Club leaders – the President, Secretary, Treasurer, Executive Secretary, Foundation Chair and Membership Chair can edit goals and achievements.

Take advantage of creating goals and plans to help your Club grow and be successful. It is simple and easy and useful for comparing your Club's achievements with other Clubs in the District.

For example, there is a graph that shows your Club's membership during the past five years. When you click on the tabs in the legend, you are able to add or remove features in this chart, and then when you hover bars or lines in the chart you will see extra details.
