Only 2% of the charities have received at least 7 consecutive 4-star evaluations, indicating that The Rotary Foundation of Rotary International outperforms most other charities in America.

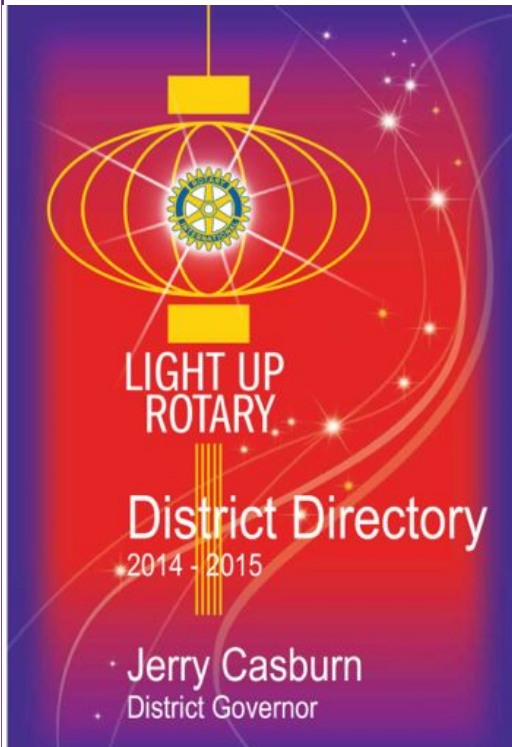

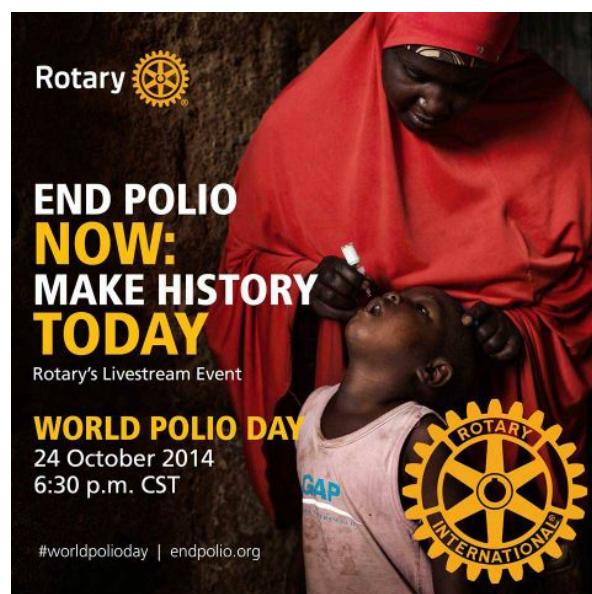
World Polio Day

Jean Jacques will conduct tours of the Inca sites such as **Machu Picchu, Sacred Valley, Ollantaytambo, Chinchero, Lake Titicaca** and much, much more – not on the normal tourist routes.

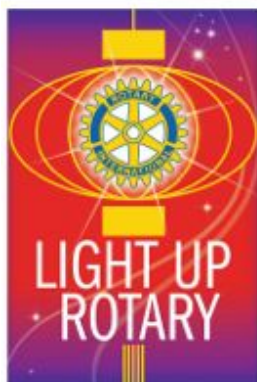
