Peter Walsh – ABC Sports Doyen

Peter was a sports mad youngster at White Flat in Ballarat - football, cricket, tennis, and athletics.



His real goal was always to sit behind a microphone and broadcast sport. Actually finishing 5 marathons (before his knees gave out) were a source of satisfaction.

His early broadcasting career started in Ballarat with 3BA in the early 70's and first real break in broadcasting VFL was in 1978. He became a full time ABC Radio Sport commentator in 1985 in Hobart.

Local broadcasting assignments include over 1,000 VFL/AFL games and 1,500 NBL/WNBL games. Internationally, he has reported on 6 Olympic Games, 5 Commonwealth Games, 2 Cricket tours and 2 Paralympic Games.

He has been fortunate enough to interview some amazing people including Muhammad Ali, Carl Lewis, Martina Navratilova, Greg

Norman, Lee Trevino, John Newcombe, Viv Richards, Sachin Tendulkar, Charles Barkley, Lauren Jackson, and Lisa Leslie.

He raises money for his favourite charity, the McGrath Foundation.

After more than 40 years of working in the media, sport is still his favourite five- letter word.

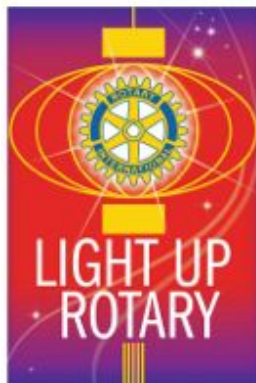
