Dear Rotarians,

The Council on Legislation met 21-26 April 2013 in Chicago, Illinois, USA. Subsequent to that meeting, Rotary's constitutional documents (the RI Constitution, the RI Bylaws, and the Standard Rotary Club Constitution) have been revised to include all the amendments adopted by the Council. The English revised constitutional documents are now available online. They have also been posted on the Policy Documents portion of rotary.org. Translations will be posted once they are available. The revised documents will also be included in the 2013 Manual of Procedure, which will be ready for distribution in October 2013.
