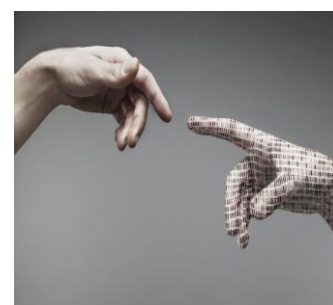

I am pleased to report \$6280.80 was raised this past Rotary year 2012 – 2013 for the Cathy Freeman Foundation for Indigenous Youth as a result of stamp collection.

The total funds raised since inception in 1991 now totals \$75,740-00, which has been distributed to many Rotary programs, e.g. Polio Plus over \$23,000, Mine Detection in Cambodia \$2165-00, Sight for Eyes in Nepal \$2641-00, Fred Hollows Foundation \$10,287-00, Wheelchairs for Disabled Children \$10,000-00, Plumpy Nuts for Darfur (nutritional aid for malnourished children) \$5008-00, Bio Sand Filters for Honduras \$5000-00, RAM (Rotary Malaria nets) \$4972-00, Adult Migrant Literacy Program \$3746-00, and several other smaller donations.

I urge you all to consider contributing to this worthwhile cause in recycling stamps, at the same time helping the environment.

The cause for 2013 – 2014 is Water Pumps for Moradabad, India.
