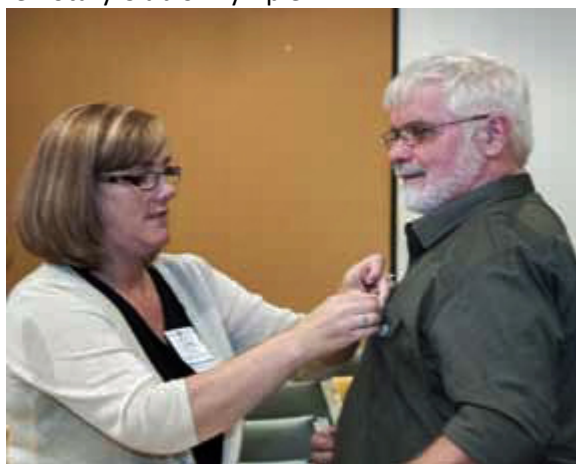
Ian McMahon has been inducted as a member of the Rotary Club of Irymple.

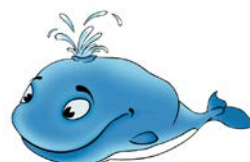
Hi, I'm Graham Pennington - Immediate Past President

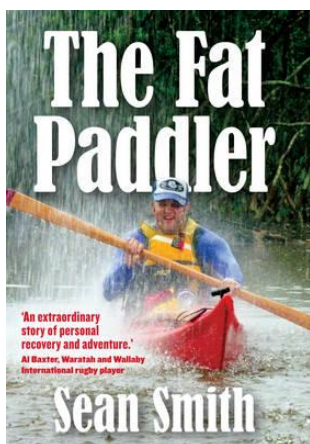
