Rotary Connect Mentoring Program 2013

Flinders University, in partnership with Rotary, is delivering a mentoring program to international students to offer them the opportunity to access advice and support of Rotary Mentors.

20 suitable international students commit to the program and are matched to a Rotary Mentor to undertake a one to one mentoring relationship.

Mentees will be selected from the discipline areas of Allied Health and Business/Commerce and where possible, matched to Mentors from related professional backgrounds.

The Program will commence in early April 2013, run across 6 months and consist of a minimum of 6 meetings (including at least 4 face to face). This enables Mentees to fully benefit from the experience, insights and knowledge of their Mentors. The length of the meetings will be at the discretion of the Mentor and determined by the purpose and goals set for each meeting.

The objectives of the Mentoring program include:

- Professional role modelling and vocational guidance to Mentees
- International students increasing their understanding of local workplace practices and employer expectations
- Mentors contributing to the professional communication skills of international students and offering them the opportunity to improve their English language proficiency during face to face meetings
- Increased profile of Rotary on campus, specifically targeting membership of the Flinders University Rotaract
 club
- Potential for Mentors to provide Mentees with professional contacts and act as a possible referee (where appropriate)

The Careers and Employers Liaison Centre will fully support the Program, manage all operational aspects and be the primary point of contact for the Mentees.

Timor-Leste is one of the poorest countries in the world, with basic income, health, and literacy levels similar to those of countries in sub-Saharan Africa."


CAN YOU HFLP?

The Awards and the requirements for submission, where applicable, are listed on pages 38, 39, and 40 of the 2012 / 2013 District Directory.


