#### Who can apply?

- all Year 11 students interested in a career in science, engineering, technology or a related area, and who are:
- planning to study science, engineering, technology or a related course at an Australian university
- an Australian citizen or who has permanent residency status
- achieving good marks in science, but also demonstrating overall excellence in their studies
- showing potential for future achievement in science or engineering for themselves, the community and the nation

We are not just looking for students with top marks in science. We are seeking students with a wide range of interests both inside and outside school, and who have strong positive connections within their community.

Attendance at the NYYS is an opportunity to learn more about the sciences, careers and study opportunities, helping students to make informed decisions and develop networks that can help them into the future. NYSF also focusses on the development of students' personal skills, including leadership, communication and team skills.
