Emergency Medical Information Booklets



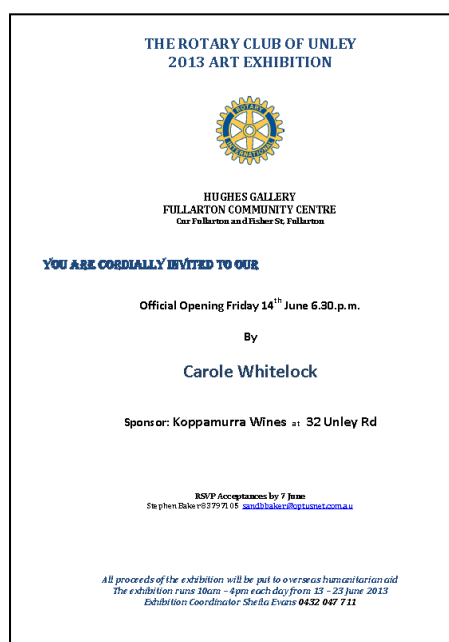
As a Community Service Project initiated by the Rotary Clubs of Tea Tree Gully, Modbury and Golden Grove, The Emergency Medical Information Booklet is now being used in every state of Australia.

The EMIB was developed by a Paramedic for Paramedics as a record of a patient's medical history and medications, which then allows Paramedics to start treatment on arrival. If a patient is transported to hospital or medical centre all the information required for admittance is written in the Emergency Information Booklet.
